"Hindered Prayer"

"Behold, the Lord's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save: nor His ear heavy, that it cannot hear. But your iniquities have separated you from your God; and your sins have hidden His face from you, so that He will not hear." (Isa 59:1-2)

Hello, Friends: How would you respond to the following question: What do you believe is the greatest consequence of sin? Would you answer: Broken marriages and families? Financial calamity? Rebellion against authority? Societal addictions? Surely, these are of great consequence, however I believe that there may be a greater repercussion for sin that exists in the life of a believer.

Pastors are often asked, "Why are my prayers going unheard by God?" My consistent answer is this: "Is there any unconfessed sin in your life?" Beloved, unconfessed sin is the major roadblock to effective communication with God! Scripture identifies three areas of sin in our lives that can hinder our petitions to the Lord.


Slothfulness is a hindrance to effective prayer. Are you slothful in your prayer life? James 4:2c reminds us that "we do not have because we do not ask." Are you persistent in prayer, or are your petitions a "one-anddone" event? Often, believers are slothful because they are unwilling to petition on God's terms, not willing to acknowl-

edge full dependence upon Him, and submit to His timing and will. Do you pray to the Father in secret (Matt 6:6)? Do you accompany prayer with biblical fasting (Matt 6:16-18)? Selfishness is a barrier to communication with God. Are you selfish when you pray? Do you pray to satisfy personal gratification, or to honor and glorify God? James warns believers that "they ask wrongly, and do not receive." (James 4:3) A way to combat selfishness in your prayer life is through a partnership with a godly prayer warrior. Don't allow the sin of selfishness to "keep good from you." Jeremiah 5:25). Lastly, small faith obstructs correspondence with the Father. In Luke 17, Jesus spoke of three types of faith: faithless, little faith, and great faith. Do you have the faith that pleases God (Heb 11:6)? One that accepts His perfect will, timing, and direction? We must have that faith that trusts a Savior that will always do what is right, that is filled with compassion for His children, and will certainly respond to His beloved ones who cry out from help.

Beloved, do not allow your precious communication with a compassionate, responsive God to be hindered by unconfessed






