Church News

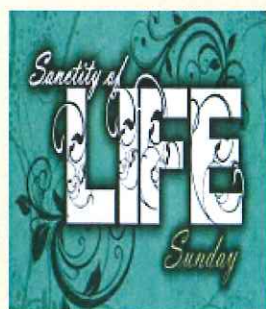

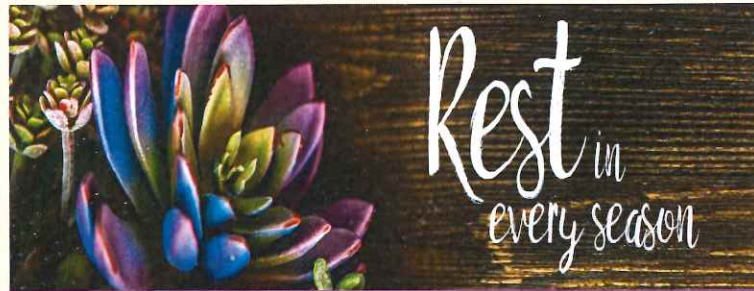
