The Pure Gospel

The Epistle of Galatians stands with the Epistle of Romans as the two books of the New Testament that every Christian should endeavor to study and dig out their message. Martin Luther viewed Galatians as one of the most important doctrinal books in the cannon of Scripture. This is because the Holy Spirit, through Paul sets forth the doctrine and defense of the Pure Gospel, as Luther put it. It is notable that God will take three New Testament books (Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:11 and Hebrews 10:38) to develop and define that one small and verse in Habakkuk 2:4 "Behold, his soul which is lifted up (proud) is not upright in him: but the just shall live by faith."

Paul, under divine inspiration, makes us aware of "another gospel" which of course, is not the pure Gospel at all. But is a "perverted" (Galatians 1:6-7) gospel. Vine's defines that word in the Greek "to transform into something of an opposite character." The results of "another gospel" being proclaimed and even received would naturally produce a false result. Hebrews 12:8 indicates that there can be those who may think themselves to be Christians but are false.

It staggering and should God's at concern us that many of the statics that are given today about the number of unchurched that are members of churches is staggering. In addition to this, is the large number of people who will

identify themselves as Christian and yet have no interest in spiritual things and seldom if ever attend a church. But, Jesus loves the Church and died for it.

Yet the Bible says in Romans 1:16 that Gospel is the power of God unto salvation. The greatest of all God's acts was the declaration of His love for man through the gift of His only Son, Jesus Christ. May God help us to declare the Pure Gospel
